- 3. Signboard at entry to Rustlewood has arrived and we are waiting for digging clearance by County and for decent weather for installation.
- 4. Next Annual meeting is to be held on Sunday, June 11, 2017 at 1:00PM. Three board member positions are to be voted upon as their two-year terms have expired.
- 5. Bill Walker and Michael Bigelow went to the County Water Department to meet the new administrator regarding the Rustlewood water situation. They discovered that our wells license need to be updated which will cost \$5000. This requirement/fee is sometimes waived. There was also a discussion about the promise of water meters for each residence. Rustlewood on an average is using far too much water per household. Grants are available for funds to cover the water meters but so far none has been applied for.
- 6. Fire Commission meetings are the 3rd Wednesday of each month at 7:00PM. All are encouraged to attend, especially to let them know that Rustlewood is concerned and interested in what the issues are and want to be involved.
